A few years ago, Solvay, now Syensqo, announced the launch of the Green Hydrogen Platform, offering ionomers and other high-performance materials for Fuel Cells and Electrolyzers which find use from the core, to the stack, to the plant. Common applications include membranes, electrode binders, hydrogen gaskets, diaphragms, enclosures, hydrogen cell frames and end plates, in addition to uses in thermal management and air systems.

Imre started his career with DuPont in 1991 in Geneva Switzerland. Until 2015, Imre held a variety of positions in Technical Support, Manufacturing, Marketing & Product Management, Sales & Business Development, Strategy / M&A, and Global Business Management, located in the UK, Germany and Switzerland.
